Lake Tyers - December 18; January 3.

Lakes Entrance - Late December; early January.

Sperm Whale Head - January 3.

It would appear that Sydney Airport is the only colony of the Little Tern at present receiving the regular attention of banders. There is no doubt that the study of this species would be greatly accelerated if additional colonies could be brought under regular scrutiny. In addition to the contribution which an expanded banding programme would make towards the solution of the problems discussed in this article, it is likely that valuable information concerning the transfer of breeding adults and the exchange of young newly-matured birds between colonies would be gained. To this end, the co-operation of any bander or observer who may be able to add to the rather meagre knowledge of the species is earnestly sought by the writer who will be glad to receive correspondence on the subject.
